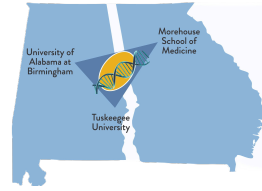

- University of Alabama at Birmingham (UAB)

PROGRAM DETAILS

- Work with cancer researchers and scientists
- Introduction to cancer research with faculty mentors
- Develop a comprehensive career plan
- Classes in Career Roadmaps, Scientific Writing, and Cultural Competency
- MCAT and GRE workshops
- Stipend: \$1,400 per month (\$2,800 for the summer)
- Housing (subject to availability):
 - Morehouse School of Medicine for AUCC trainees
 - UAB for Tuskegee students only (not available to UAB students)
